

RIMpro-BIOFIX 2016

Update 10 April 25

Actual information on phenology, ascospore maturation and first discharge to help consultants and producers to set the correct Biofix date for RIMpro-*Venturia*. This information is provided by research institutes and advisory services. Observations over the past 15 years have learned that 'Green Tip' is not always the best Biofix setting. The first ascospores were found between 21 days before Green Tip, until 17 days after. Best simulation results were obtained by using as Biofix:



Date of first observed ascospore discharge, or date of Green tip, whatever comes first
